MEMORANDUM FOR THE ITALIAN MILITARY REPRESENTATIVE

SUBJECT: ACP 104

References: a. Italian MilRep ltr 0642 of 15 April 1955
 b. SGM-178-55

1. The Standing Group has considered the proposals forwarded by the reference and comments as follows in reply:

a. In regard to paragraph 1 of reference a, it is regretted that the request for listing of geographic locations in the Italian language cannot be approved for the following reasons:

(1) It is considered that the policy furnished by reference b is still pertinent and also applicable to the call sign and address group publications.

(2) The listing of call sign and address group assignments in other than English language is undesirable since such a practice would eventually change the publications into multilingual documents.

(3) To insure maximum effectiveness, the geographic listings in ACP 104 must be prepared in the language employed by a majority of users of this publication.

(4) In the interest of standardization, it is considered that listings in ACP 104 and other ACPs must be in the language in which the publications were offered. In cases when the English version is not understood, a translation prepared locally is recommended.

b. In regard to paragraph 2 of reference a, the following address groups have been assigned as indicated and will be confirmed in Change No. 4 to ACP 104(A):

ESJE - Bologna, Italy	BZUZ - Lecce, Italy

ODFO - Capua, Italy	HZCN - Novara, Italy

Vigna di Valle is listed in ACP 104 as Vigna d Valle, Italy, and no change is considered necessary. The remainder of the listed localities appear to be sub-divisions or suburban areas of another city or town. The addition of such less populated locales to the geographical list is undesirable due to their limited application. In lieu thereof, it is considered that the assignment of individual address groups to the military activity plus the location, will serve a more useful purpose. The inclusion of such assignments in appropriate ACPs would eliminate the requirement for conjunctive type address groups and thus maintain the geographical listings to reasonable proportion.

2. Accordingly, it is requested that the Italian authorities reconsider the requirement for inclusion in ACP 104 of the locations not provided for in paragraph 1b above.

3. The listings for "Territory of Trieste" and "Trieste free Territory" have been deleted from ACP 104(A) by Change No. 3.
